Introduction

Targeted Clients

- ◆ Individuals with a developmental disability who have an interest in supported employment on a fee-for-service basis. (All clients will receive continuous on-site supervision.)
- ◆ And individuals with a developmental disability who have an interest in wellness services to complement their employment at Causeway. (All clients will receive on-site instruction.)

Krackers Katering

- ◆ The growth of Causeway's catering business, Krackers Katering, has opened up paid work opportunities suitable for clients with developmental disabilities.

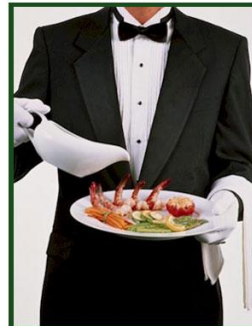
Increasing Demand

- ◆ Among the growing number of social enterprises in the City of Ottawa, this is one of the first to work with the developmental sector.
- ◆ There is a limited number of openings in the existing supported employment programs for this sector.

Program Goals

Program Goals

- ◆ To integrate clients with a developmental disability into a supervised work environment in which they can learn work skills on the job in a paid work opportunity



Program Objectives

- ◆ To provide clients with a “real” job in a reputable business, with good business practices.
- ◆ Closing the circle—Krackers is pleased to be able to direct its employee wages to clients with developmental disabilities, in whom these social investments are made.

Program Activities

Client Responsibilities

- ◆ Expected to work 2 - 3 hours per day for a maximum of 12 hours per week preparing the goods ordered
- ◆ Participate in food preparation, food packaging, and kitchen clean-up under staff supervision

Staff Responsibilities

- ◆ Perform purchasing, preparation, delivery, and on-site supervision
- ◆ Teach, support, and assist the clients in food preparation

Wellness Component

- ◆ The clients would be eligible for wellness services (fitness, social-recreation) at a local gym and/or in Causeway's wellness facility.
- ◆ Structured exercise programs, fitness instruction, and group classes are provided by a recreologist and a personal trainer.
